Today's Lesson – The Winning Mindset What's it All About?

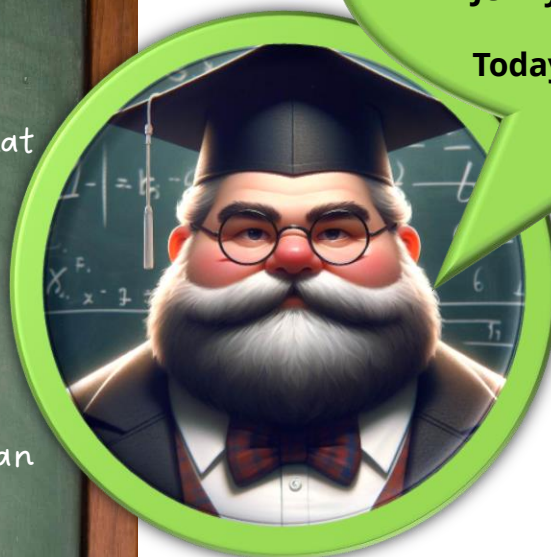
Whether you left school 4 years ago or 40, the chances are that classroom events just like this one have influenced your life.

After all, the "Boss wants to see you" really is not that far from "wait outside the headmasters office."

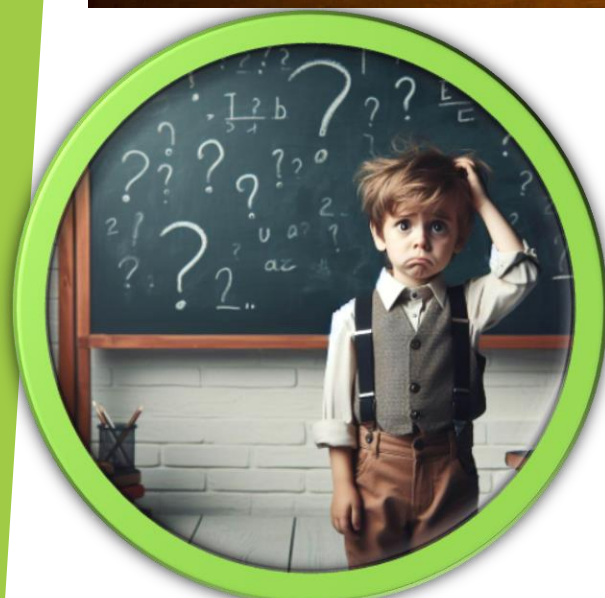


Morning Class, settle down now.

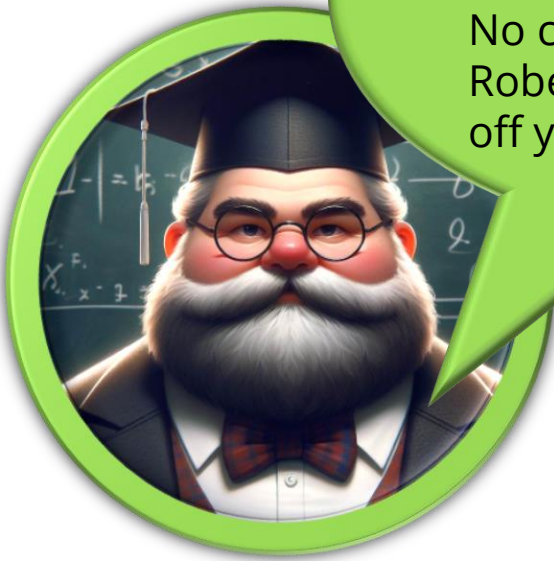

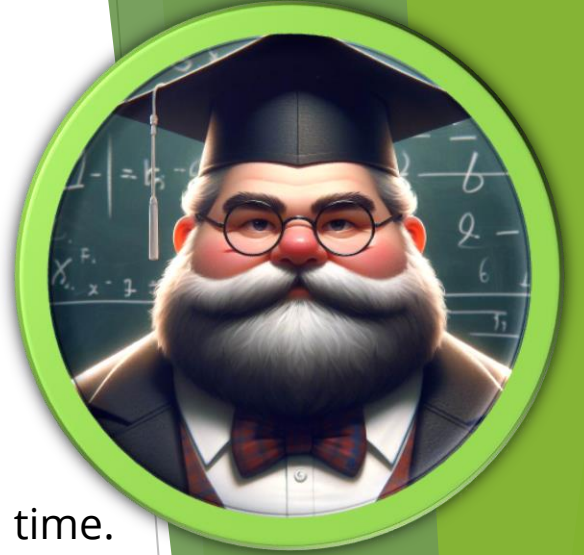


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Frequently Asked Questions



How long does the program last?

12 month's, meeting once a month, with 12 seminars lasting up to 2 hours each time.

Is there homework?

Yes, but nothing onerous and rarely mandatory, again, your choice

What does it cost?

£60:00 per month, paid via Stripe which means you manage your payments not us.

Can I remain Anonymous?

Not in the meetings, outside that nobody will know you are attending.

Can you do it all in one go?

In short, no.

Can I leave at any time?

Yes, this is why we charge monthly, the option is always yours.

Who is the program for?

The program is open to anyone over the age of 18.

Who is the program not suitable for?

Ask yourself the following...

- If you believe that “virtue signalling” and “affinity groups” are a good idea, then walk on by.

How does the joining process work?

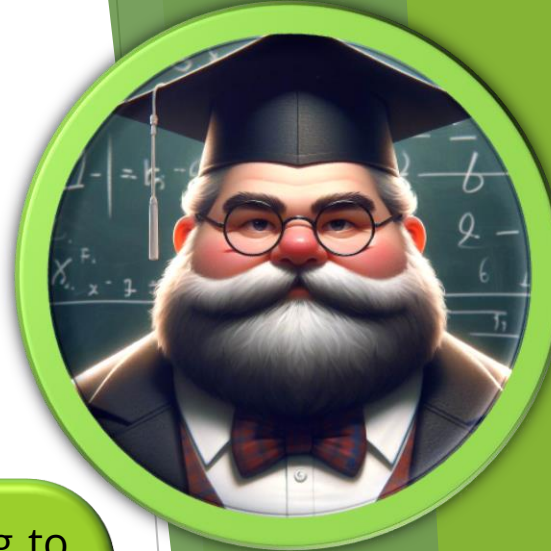
Once you have used the click me to join link below you will be directed to a contact form.

1. Complete the form and decide the time you would like to attend every month.
2. You will then receive a welcome e-mail inviting you set up your Stripe account and make a £1:00 payment which gives you access to the WhatsApp group.
3. You will receive a link to the WhatsApp group within 24 hours of account setup.
4. Here you can meet your fellow starters.
5. Near the start date you will receive a link to set up the recurring payment
6. Then you will be allocated to a group based on your flexibility on attendance time.
7. Tech meetings then take place so you can test Microsoft teams if required
 - I. You **must** have a camera.
 - II. Desktop/Laptop is the best way to attend
 - III. Tablets etc are next
 - IV. Mobiles can be tricky with reading on-screen materials
